Here's a high-level assessment and response plan addressing the damage caused by Cyclone Dana in the Sundarbans and East Midnapore of West Bengal, as well as Kendrapara and Bhadrak in Odisha. Mukti volunteers are in contact with local communities and have initiated an immediate response.

Response and Recovery Plan in West Bengal

No of Families	Per family	Amount Needed	Support Plan
25000	₹700	₹1,75,00,000	Seed support for winter vegetable farming, kitchen gardens, and Boro paddy seeds, among others.

- ⇒ **Ration Kit**: Each unit, containing rice, dal, oil, soap, biscuits, soybean, salt, and puffed rice, costs Rs 500. These kits will support community kitchens for one to four weeks, depending on the impact and situation.
- ⇒ **Baby Food and Hygiene Kit**: Each unit, containing milk powder, biscuits, soap, and Dettol, will be distributed at a cost of Rs 500.
- ⇒ Education Material: Support will be provided to students who lost their books and stationery at a cost of Rs 700.
- ⇒ **Tarpaulin Support**: One unit per family, costing Rs 1,000, will be provided as temporary support for families with partially or fully damaged houses.
- ⇒ **Vegetable Seed Support**: Each unit, containing 2-5 types of seeds, will be given to affected farmers at a cost of Rs 500, particularly those practicing climate-resilient or organic farming.
- ⇒ **Rebuilding Infrastructure**: Support for labor costs for rebuilding homes and common infrastructure will be provided on a case-by-case basis to restore normalcy.

I urge concerned individuals, philanthropic organizations, and CSR teams to join us in our disaster recovery efforts and help restore normalcy to our community.
